



## BLOWER DOOR TEST POLICY

The St. Louis County Residential Inspector does not need to witness the blower door test. A completed form with acceptable criteria must be submitted to the inspector before the blower door inspection is approved. The test is required to be conducted in accordance with ASTM E 1827 or ASTM E 779 as indicated in Section N1102.4.1.2 (R402.4.1.2) of the International Residential Code/2015.
